The MRI confirmed this great news and there was no need for the CAT scan or spinal tap and he would not go blind! He is thanking God for the great outcome and sister Lakisha is celebrating the awesome outcome, that when we stand in faith, nothing is impossible for Jesus, our Healer! Hallelujah!!
