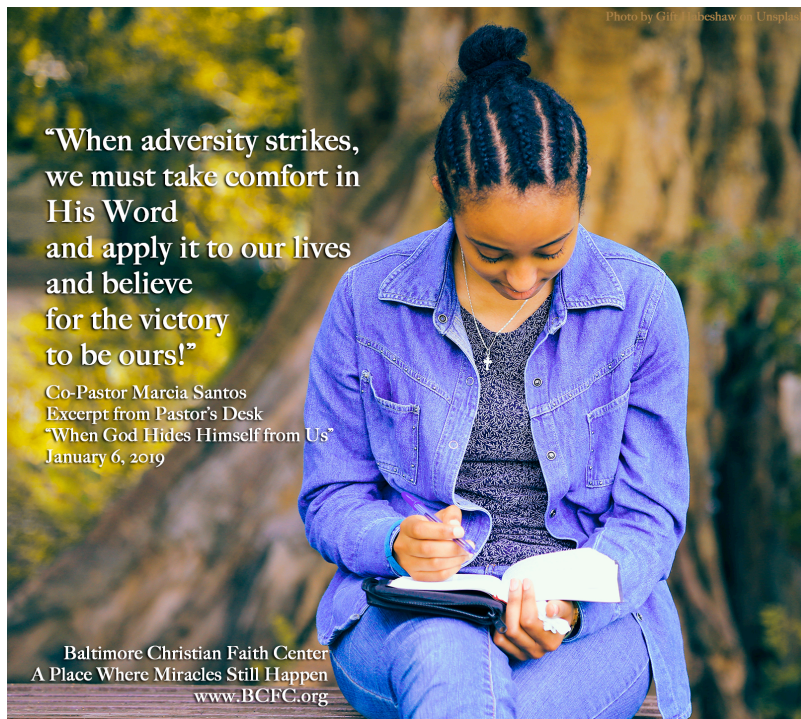


When God Hides Himself from Us
