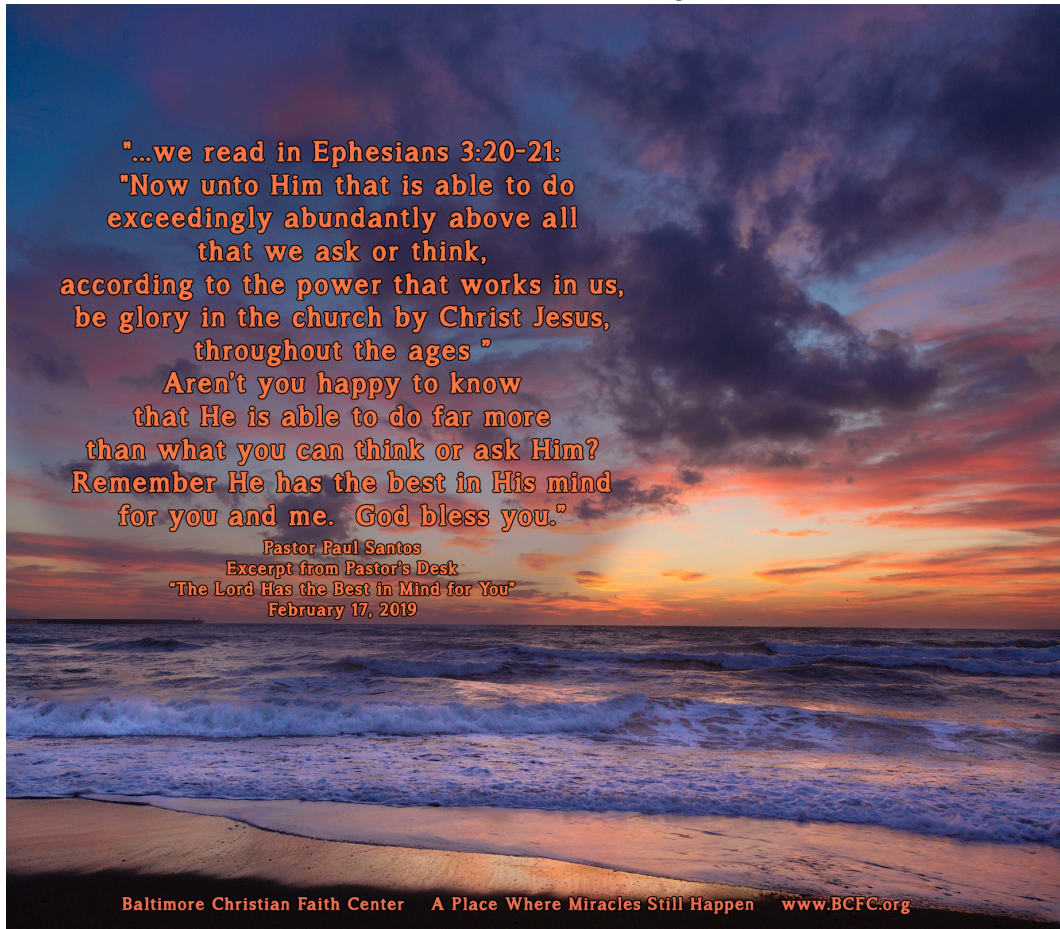


The Lord Has the Best in Mind for You
