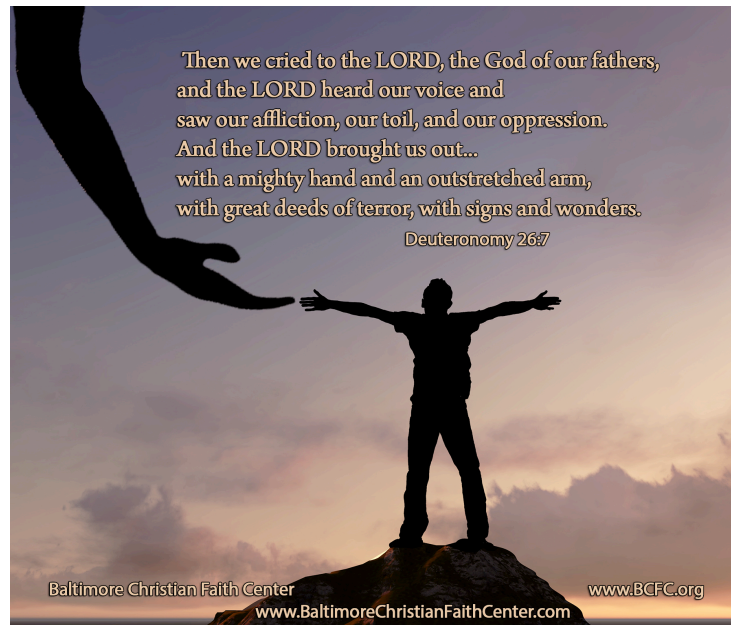


The God Of our Fathers. אֱלֹהֵינוּ אֱבִי יִהְיֶה “Elohey Avoteynu.”
