In the book of Mathew 9:27-31 we read a story of two blind men receiving healing from Jesus Christ. The Lord Jesus asked them if they believed He was able to heal them. They immediately replied: Yes!!! Then Our Lord Jesus said to them: "Be it done according to your faith."

The word "according" which is the Greek word "Katah" speaks of intensity, which it is joined, in the manner of, and in proportion to... your FAITH.

The Lord Jesus did not believe for them. The two blind men already had sufficient faith to produce their miracle, so why hadn't they been healed before? I believe that until then, they had no Savior in whom to put their faith. All of us have a measure of faith in us.

When I look at the world around us today, I often ask: "Who are we putting our faith in? Honestly, who do we believe in, so strongly that a miracle can take place on the spot, based on our Faith? Who do we believe in?"

It is my prayer and hope that we are following the example of the two blind men, and obeying the scriptures, when it says: "looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of OUR faith." Hebrews 12:2.
