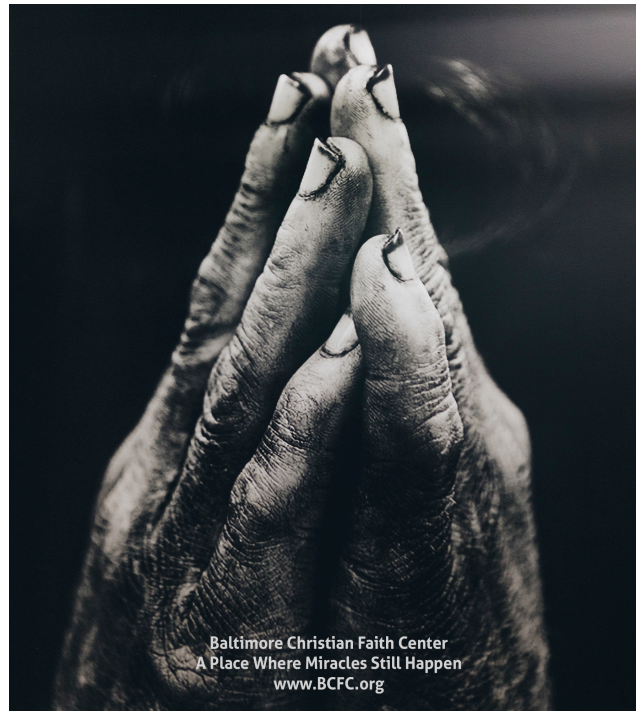


Praying Through and In the Holy Spirit
