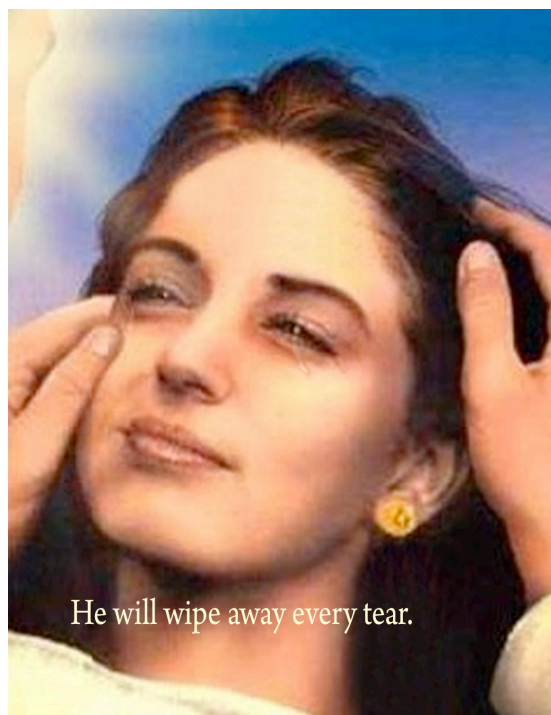


Be Brave, Trust the Lord, and Don't Lose Heart!

In today's confused world where right became wrong and, in the mind of twisted people, wrong has become right, it takes some bravery to continue to believe and trust in the Lord. I guess that's why King David said in Psalm 27:14, "Trust the LORD! Be brave and strong and trust the LORD."

Amidst so much injustice and calamities wherever we turn, there are so much tragedies and mishappenings that it's easy to be shaken in our beliefs and ask, "Where is God?" What happened with the world I once knew?

The Message Bible puts the same verse even better: "Stay with God! Don't quit. I'll say it again: Stay with God." As tough, difficult, hard and disheartening things may be, always remember 2 Corinthians 3:18, 4:1 – "And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image (of Christ) from one degree of glory to another.
