A young man approached me once, upset with God because of the fact that everybody at his workplace was being promoted and he was passed by. He went on to ask why God was doing that to him. I kindly responded: If this is God's doing, get ready for a management position; if not, it's time to get your act together!

James tells us (James 1:17): "Every desirable and beneficial gift comes out of heaven. The gifts are rivers of light cascading down from the Father of Light. There is nothing deceitful in God, nothing two-faced, nothing fickle." (MSG)

The young man went on to ask me: What do you mean? (GV)
