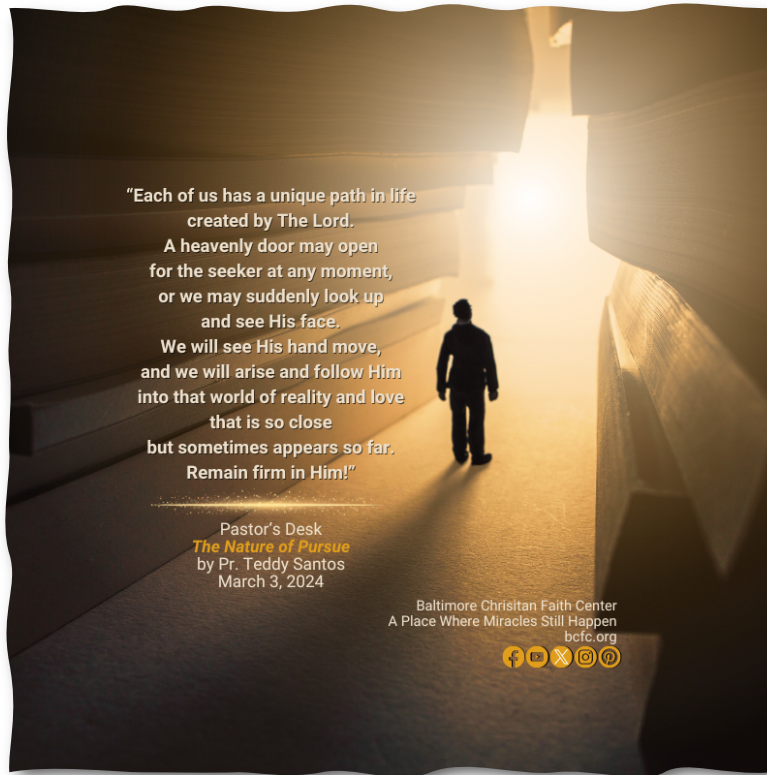


The Nature of Pursue
