
Allow God to Decide Pastor's Desk – August 20, 2023



Genesis 13:10-11 "10 And Lot lifted his eyes and saw all the plain of Jordan, that it was well watered everywhere (before the LORD destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah) like the garden of the LORD, like the land of Egypt as you go toward Zoar. **11** Then Lot chose for himself all the plain of Jordan, and Lot journeyed east. And they separated from each other."

The person that has accepted God as their portion can afford to be generous! As the more aged man, Abraham could have claimed his portion first; but he was content to waive his privileges since his Almighty Friend had appointed the place he was to receive his heritage. "Wait on the LORD, And keep His way, And He shall exalt you to inherit the land..." Psa 37:34.
