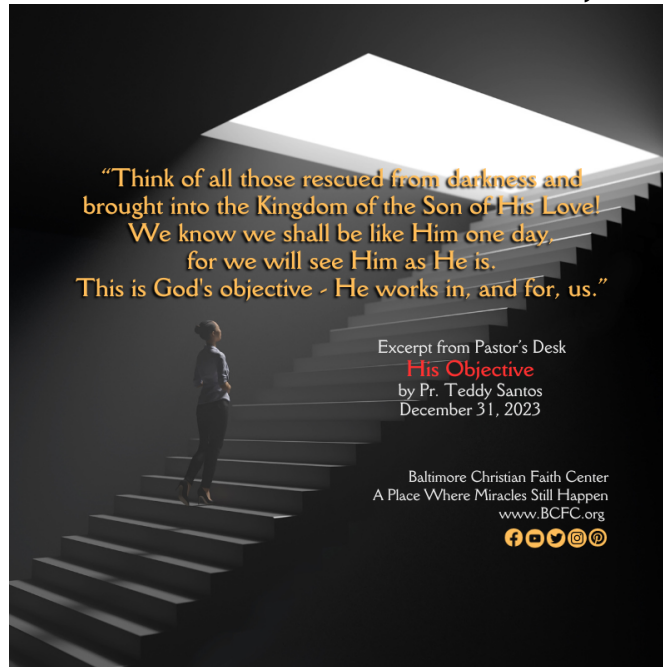


His Objective
